Rear Admiral Samuel Cox, a retired naval officer who is now Director of the *Naval History and Heritage Command* as well as Curator of the Navy, will give a talk at the beginning of the event. Afterwards there will be a screening of *D-Day's Sunken Secrets*, an internationally acclaimed documentary about the critical role played by the Navy during the most ambitious and risky military operation ever launched.

Sylvain Pascaud, the documentary's chief writer, will be present for Q&A. Featured on the PBS show *NOVA* as well as on France 3's program *Thalassa*, *D-Day's Sunken Secrets* analyzes the technologies which were instrumental to the allies' ultimate victory. It follows divers, submarines and underwater robots as they discover the remnants of this day. The documentary also features interviews of veterans who share first-hand accounts of their experience. Guests will then be invited to discuss their thoughts over a glass of wine.
